Sight Words Go Fish is just like regular Go Fish.

The object of the game is get as many pairs of matching cards as you can.

To play, you ask another player for a specific card by name. If she has that card, you get to lay down the pair in front of you. If she doesn't, you have to go fish or choose a card from those remaining in a mixed up (face down) pile on the table.

You play until all of the cards on the table have been played. The player with the most pairs wins.

Normally, each pair of cards would have a unique picture that allows children to identify the matching pair. In sight words go fish, the pictures are all the same. In order to find a match, players *must* read the words.

You will need to print out 2 copies of each of the following pages in order to play Go Fish. If more than 2 people will be playing, you may want to print out an extra set of pages for each person.
